Pedoulas village, seat of the Cyprus Youth Symphony Orchestra Summer Academy, lies in the Troodos mountains in an enchanting location 1200 m. above sea level.

Participating students are offered scholarships, which include free tuition, full board and transport within Cyprus. The final concert is included in the *Kypria 2009 International Festival*, organized by the Cyprus Ministry of Education and Culture. The Festival is the most important annual cultural event in Cyprus.

Venue for the final concert is the Strovolos Municipal Theatre by the capital city, Nicosia. It is a modern concert hall inaugurated in 2003. Its excellent acoustics make it the best auditorium in Cyprus.
